Disposition of Minutes:

- 2) The diocese gathers together every year the Sunday during the month of November to pray for the deceased. Bishop Parks has been there the last two years. Fr. is going to invite the parish to do that with him on November 6.
- 3) October 23 live rosary. We are doing well with the numbers – just short of two/three people. Fr. will lead the first part and others will follow. Fr. said that those who come from a different language will lead in their own language. He is thinking about doing it in the shape of a heart. The cross will be inside the heart. People can either sit or stand.
